



Mid-Michigan Men's Soccer League (MMMSL) Memorandum

TO: All League Participants
RE: League Meeting Minutes
DATE: December 14, 2003

Attendance: All teams were present except Mason, Owosso, and CCFC
Next League Meeting: TBD

1. Divisions for Next Season:

- Add an Open Division [9-0 in favor]
 - Limit to 6 teams for 2004 season
 - Games to be held on Wednesdays if possible (otherwise Tue or Thu)
- Add an Over 40 Division [9-0 in favor]
 - Will play on smaller fields on Wednesdays if possible (otherwise Tue or Thu)
 - Will play short-sided
- Change existing Over 30/Over 35 Division to be a strictly Over 30 Division [5-4 in favor]
 - Will play on Sundays
 - Teams in favor: Grand Saints United, Okemos, East Lansing, Haslett, Flying Eagles; Teams opposed: Meridian, DeWitt, Lansing, Williamston

2. Player Passes:

- 1st Option: John Walenburg will check to see if we can arrange to have player passes made at Kinko's
- 2nd Option: MMMSL will create our own player passes – print on paper with photo (or attach photo after printing), then laminate
- 3rd Option: Contract Midland league to create our player passes for us

3. New MMMSL Board Structure Proposal:

- Propose a new Board Structure:
 - President
 - 3 Vice Presidents (one for each division) – will represent division, investigate erroneous/incomplete game reports, chair disciplinary hearings, schedule season
 - 3 Registrars (one for each division) – will handle registrations for their division
 - Secretary/Webmaster
 - Treasurer
- Will be put to vote at next league meeting

4. Field Scheduling:

Unanimous decision – for all divisions, the number one priority is to play games at the Kenneth Hope Complex or at the East Lansing Soccer Complex. Within reason, game times will deviate from the traditional 4 PM/6 PM start times (on Sundays) in order to play at those 2 complexes. Games may start as early as 2 PM on Sundays, or may be played on Saturdays. This should only be an issue during the spring and fall.

5. Miscellaneous:

- Tournament of Champions (MSA): June 5-6, 2004 [CCFC will represent MMMSL]
- Michigan Challenge Cup (MSA): July 11, July 18, August 1 [MMMSL can send several teams, the proposal is to send one or more “All Star” teams]
- Question: If a player plays in several divisions within the MMMSL, must that player pay the MSA the individual registration fee several times (one payment per team), or must that player pay the individual registration fee only once? Mike Yassine will investigate.
